

Applicants must be a least 18 (eighteen) years of age and furnish all information required by the Ironworkers Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee, including a copy of the applicant's birth certificate and a transcript of grades, a recent doctor's certificate must be submitted, evidencing the applicant's freedom from any drug or alcohol dependency, and the physical and mental fitness required to safely perform the work expected of an Ironworker apprentice, a High School Diploma or GED in order to receive credit. The IWJATC must receive the required documentation within ten business days of completing the mandatory 10-hour Safety and Orientation class, or the applicant will be removed from consideration from the program. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in automatic disqualification.

Selection of apprentices shall be made from qualified applicants on the basis of qualification alone. The recruitment, selection, employment and training of apprentices during their apprenticeship shall be made without discrimination because of age, race, color, religion, marital status, disability, sex, ancestry, or national origin.
